



Millennium Tempo Maintenance Guidelines

- Laminate flooring is best maintained at a temperature of 17-23°C (62-73°F) with a relative humidity of 35-50%. If the relative humidity drops below 30% this may result in damage to the floor. Follow all the manufacturer's instructions regarding temperature and humidity requirements
- For routine maintenance a specially-formulated hardwood or laminate spray cleaner is recommended. Do not use a wet spray micro fiber mop to clean. Use a well-rung out damp cloth to clean up any dirt and footprints but avoid excessive moisture
- Never use wax, polish or scouring agents as they may dull or distort the finish. Use acetone or a specially-formulated laminate cleaner to remove stubborn marks
- Clean up all spills immediately
- To avoid scratches apply felt pads to your furniture legs and use only soft rubber casters
- Protect high traffic areas with runners and area rugs
- Consider keeping a few extra Manor House boards on hand in case of accidental damage. Boards can be replaced or repaired by flooring professionals
- Improper care and maintenance of your laminate floor may void your warranty. See carton insert for details
